Requirements for articles:

- The article should not exceed 4-5 pages in Lithuanian or English, in A4 format, MC Word, Times New Roman.
- **Title of article:** All caps, Centered, **Bold** 14 pt, single line spacing.
- **Author(s) name(s), surname(s):** Centered, **Bold, Italic** 12 pt.
- **Scientific supervisor: name, surname:** Centered, **Bold, Italic** 12 pt.
- **Institution:** Centered, Italic, 12 pt.
- **Headings:** Centered, **Bold**, 12 pt.
- **Main body text:** Normal, 12 pt, 1,5 line spacing.
- **Introduction, chapters and conclusions (title Bold, text Normal, 12 pt.**
- **Tables, pictures** (title Centered, text, 10 pt, Normal), Arabic numbering should be used.
- **Paper margins:** Top - 2,0 cm, Bottom – 2,0 cm, Left - 2,5 cm; Right -1,5 cm, 1,27 cm - First Line Indentation.
- **List of References:** All references should be listed at the end of the paper in alphabetical order.
- **Summary:** up to 100 words, 10 pt, there should be tittle (all caps), institution, author(s), **Bold**, text 10 pt., single.
- **The text of the article is not editable. Pay attention to the language of the article.**
- Presentation must be prepared by MS PowerPoint.
