- The article should not exceed 4-5 pages in Lithuanian or English, in A4 format, MC Word, Times New Roman.
- Paper margins: Top – 2,0 cm, Bottom – 2,0 cm, Left – 2,5 cm; Right – 1,5 cm, First Line Indentation – 1,27 cm
- Title of article: All caps, Centered, Bold 14 pt, Single, Spacing After 6 pt.
- Author(s) name(s), surname(s): Centered, Bold, Italic 12 pt, 1.5 lines Line spacing
- Scientific supervisor: name, surname: Centered, Bold, Italic 12 pt, 1.5 lines Line spacing.
- Institution: Centered, Italic, 12 pt, 1.5 lines Line spacing
- Headings: Centered, Bold, 12 pt, 1.5 lines Line spacing
- Main body text: Normal, 12 pt, 1.5 lines Line spacing.
- Introduction, chapters and conclusions (title Bold, text Normal, 12 pt, 1.5 lines Line spacing).
- Tables, pictures (title Centered, text, 12 pt, Normal), Arabic numbering should be used.
- List of References: All references should be listed according to the APA citation style.
- Summary: up to 100 words, 10 pt, there should be title (all caps), institution, author(s), Bold, text 10 pt., single Line spacing.
- The text of the article is not editable. Pay attention to the language of the article.




Figure 1. Title of the figure
